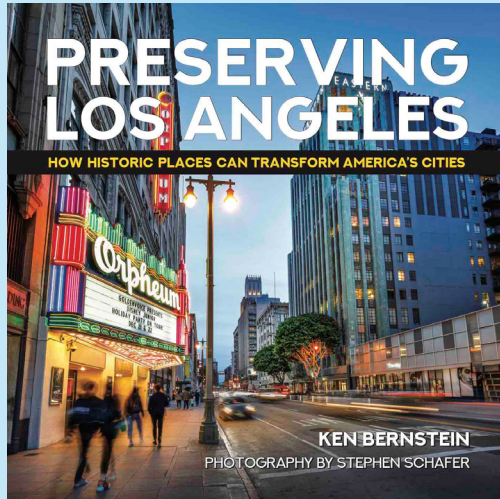

He previously directed the preservation advocacy work of the Los Angeles Conservancy, the nation's largest membership-based local preservation organization, and lectures frequently on preservation and urban planning.
